# **Measuring For Your Countertop**

To get an accurate estimate for your new countertops, take a moment to measure your existing space before meeting with an MC Granite Project Manager. Follow these simple steps and use the graph paper on the back to sketch your kitchen countertop layout and record measurements.

### Measure your countertop

- Measure the length and width of each countertop section in inches (see examples on the left). Round all numbers to the nearest half-inch.
- Record your measurements in the provided table on the back.
- Multiply the length by the width for each section to get the area in square inches.
- Total the area for each section to determine the overall square inches for your countertops.
- Divide the total square inch area by 144 to get the total square footage.

**Note:** If you prefer, you can simply record the lengths and widths, and a Project Manager at MC Granite will handle the calculations.

## Draw your kitchen

Use the graph paper on the back to sketch your countertop layout. Each square on the paper represents 1' x 1'. Identify: **finished edges** (use a "0" for finished edges), **walls**, **areas for backsplashes** (use "BS" to indicate backsplashes), **cooktops**, **free-standing and drop-in ranges**, **dishwasher**, **refrigerator**, **sink**.




# **Bring Your Worksheet To MC Granite**




